- Still dealing with effects of staffing in some areas (reduced services)

What's New

- FTA Lo-No Grant for Facilities
 - SMART worked with MNDOT on federal Lo-No grant this past spring and it was selected as one
 of three Minnesota projects
 - \$6.2M grant will help fund both Austin and Waseca facilities (MNDOT will cover remainder of cost)
 - Announced on July 9th, the 60th Anniversary of the Federal Transit Program
 - SMART Facebook page has a lot of info on FTA and the 60th Anniversary
- o 10th Anniversary
 - SMART continues to celebrate our 10 Year Anniversary
 - Will be providing free rides to all passengers on Monday, September 23rd as a special thank you to all of them, and to continue our celebration of our 10th Anniversary
 - Continue to highlight the work of SMART and public transportation via social media
 - Will likely do one more activity towards the end of the year (give-away)

SMART Functional Updates

- Training
 - Working through a lot of training this past summer driver refreshers, CPR, etc.
 - Working on completing some new driver training for new staff one more driver will complete
 his road exam in a few weeks
 - Preparing for the all agency staff meeting in November (annual event held in Austin)
 - Usually have a specific training during the meeting will be doing fire training this year with member of the Austin Fire Dept.
 - With drug and alcohol have been dealing with some challenges but new methods are working out great
- Austin/Albert Lea/Dispatch
 - All services are operating in Albert Lea fully staffed and no issues (have been consistently staffed for years)
 - Ribbon cutting in Albert Lea next week to celebrate our 10th Anniversary (Wednesday, 9/18)
 - Preschool has started in Austin which is a large service for SMART
 - Have one opening in Austin cannot seem to get this last position filled
 - Updating route designs due to increased bridge construction new brochures and press releases will be sent out
 - Dispatch is seeing an increase in call volume
- Owatonna/Waseca
 - Owatonna has seen an increase in staffing which has led to an expansion of service very recently
 - Still have a couple openings in Owatonna but better
 - Preschool has started and is going well
 - Waseca service is expanding some as well with staffing assistance from other cities
 - Staffing levels continue to struggle with little luck from advertising will continue
 - New bus coming into play this week

MNDOT Update

- Capital
 - Vehicles
 - Vehicle Replacement
 - 2020-21 Bus Grants/Contracts
 - Ordered six replacement buses (from 2020 capital grant; two in Austin, two in Albert Lea, one in Owatonna, and one in Waseca)
 - Received first bus from 2020 order in May, 2022

- Ordered five replacement buses (from 2021 capital grant; one in Austin, one in Owatonna, and three in Waseca)
- 2020-21 Bus Contracts received amendments due to pricing increases
- Received two of the four buses remaining last two buses from 2021 contract will be inspected by MNDOT tomorrow; should see delivery next week
- 2022 Bus Grant/Contract
 - Approved for two buses from 2022 Vehicle Replacement grant; one in Austin, one in Albert Lea
 - Two buses have been ordered through North Central
 - Hoping to see these buses sometime this fall/winter
- o 2023 Vehicle Replacement
 - Requested eight buses for replacement, was approved for four (award letter)
 - Two buses in Austin, two buses in Owatonna
 - Significant price increase:
 - Nearly 40% over 2022 ordering price
 - Increase of 101% from 2021 ordering price
 - Recently received notice of yet another increase Now approx.
 115% increase over original 2020 price
 - Ordered four buses in early November two with I State and two with North Central
 - I State buses likely to be delivered late this month to early next month
 - North Central buses will likely be delivered late 2024 to early 2025
- o 2024 Vehicle Replacement
 - Requested eight replacement vehicles, was approved for three
 - One Albert Lea, two Austin
 - Predicted price per MnDOT is \$204,300
- o 2025 Vehicle Replacement
 - Grant application submitted requesting six buses
 - Should hear something very soon on this (state is announcing awards for projects now)
- Vehicle Disposition
 - Starting to dispose of older buses as new ones arrive
- Low-No Emission Grant BETTER
 - Worked with MNDOT and three other agencies to apply for an exciting opportunity to bring an electric bus to SMART
 - "Buses Electrified To Travel Efficiently in Rural" MN Communities application was completed the last week of May
 - o Notice was received mid-August, 2022, that MNDOT's grant was approved
 - Tentative time for bus arrival is 2025
 - Working with MNDOT consultant on the project regular meetings scheduled
- Facilities
 - Austin and Waseca facility approved through MNDOT grant Future projects
 - As noted earlier Received federal grant for these projects
 - Will work with MNDOT in coming weeks and months to determine timelines and requirements for project(s)
- Other
 - Received funding through a 2024 Technology Grant for additional camera hardware that will assist managers with accessing video footage
 - Working through procurement of this now

- Submitted 2025 Technology Grant application for new routing software
 - Awaiting announcement of awards (like vehicle grant above)
- 2025 Operating Grant application award arrived on Monday
 - Approved by MNDOT for 2025
- Big Picture Down the Road
 - Resume normal service hours
 - As SMART continues to hire more staff, we will evaluate our services and resume previously suspended services as we are able
 - Cedar Valley Services Update
 - Cedar Valley Services is very excited to work with MNDOT and the FTA on our two facility projects – this will help immensely with retaining a solid reserve fund to help with vehicles, etc.
 - Continue to work with merger in Faribault (KCQ)
 - Continue to work with communities that we serve in the Austin, Albert Lea, Owatonna, and Faribault
 - Continue to work to bring back more and more workers
