- Still dealing with some staffing challenges (especially northern counties)

What's New

- More buses
 - Received one of the 2022 buses, with second one being delivered today
 - Receiving two 2023 buses the first week or two of January
 - Anticipate remaining two buses from 2023 order later 1st Quarter 2024
- 10th Anniversary
 - SMART continues to celebrate our 10 Year Anniversary
 - Last activity of the 10th Anniversary celebration was a drawing in each community had passengers sign up last week, and drew the winners this past Monday (free monthly route pass or bag of Demand Response tokens)
 - Continue to highlight the work of SMART and public transportation via social media

SMART Functional Updates

- o Albert Lea
 - Have hired Ashley as our Operations Manager overseeing Albert Lea (Freeborn County); she is taking over for Chris who will focus her time and efforts on a busy Austin (Mower County) area
 - Chris has been working with Mayo and Naeve Hospital to secure a grant for seniors in Freeborn county to get free rides (duplicate of service in Austin)
 - Has received a lot of media attention including the Star Tribune
- Austin/Dispatch
 - Seen an uptick in passengers on our route buses
 - We have a long time employee retiring today Has been on board for 10 years now
 - Call volume is up with dispatch
 - Staffing levels are decent we have a couple openings that we are looking to fill (now with Chris retiring)
- Owatonna/Waseca
 - Waseca
 - Definitely on an uptick have hired some additional staff
 - Working on training new staff and getting them licensed and ready for the road
 - Still looking to hire more staff yet
 - Looking to expand service with our demand service expanding it from part of the day to a full day
 - Will look at expanding to our last and final demand service in early 2025 if staffing continues to improve
 - Continuing to help local schools
 - Owatonna
 - Staffing has improved some but still looking for staff
 - Services are busy and are staff are doing very well
 - The 'Santa for a Senior' event was a hit again this year and our staff purchased gifts for local seniors
- Training / D&A
 - We're planning for a MNDOT audit for the Drug and Alcohol program this next year
 - Participated in a webinar that discussed mock testing so have some planned
 - Still hoping for a saliva test option at some point
 - Have a D&A conference in our area in 2025
 - Training has been going well with a new online program it has been a learning process but getting better with each and every new hire
 - Had a great all-staff training in November in Austin
 - Had the Austin Fire Dept come and do training with all the staff
 - Had opportunity for dispatch to spend time with all the drivers from all four counties

- MNDOT Update
 - Capital
 - Vehicles
 - Vehicle Replacement
 - o 2020-21 Bus Grants/Contracts
 - All buses received
 - o 2022 Bus Grant/Contract
 - Approved for two buses from 2022 Vehicle Replacement grant; one in Austin, one in Albert Lea
 - Two buses have been ordered through North Central
 - Received one bus (first bus 10/25, second bus arriving today)
 - o 2023 Vehicle Replacement
 - Requested eight buses for replacement, was approved for four (award letter)
 - Two buses in Austin, two buses in Owatonna
 - Ordered four buses in early November, 2023 two with I State and two with North Central
 - Working with I State on bus delivery for two buses for first week or two of January
 - North Central buses will likely be delivered first quarter 2025
 - o 2024 Vehicle Replacement
 - Requested eight replacement vehicles, was approved for three
 - One Albert Lea, two Austin
 - Predicted price per MnDOT is \$204,300
 - Received approval to order today
 - 2025 Vehicle Replacement
 - Grant application submitted requesting six buses
 - Still waiting to hear from state
 - Vehicle Disposition
 - Disposing of older buses as new ones arrive
 - Low-No Emission Grant BETTER
 - Worked with MNDOT and three other agencies to apply for an exciting opportunity to bring an electric bus to SMART
 - "Buses Electrified To Travel Efficiently in Rural" MN Communities application was completed the last week of May
 - Notice was received mid-August, 2022, that MNDOT's grant was approved
 - Tentative time for bus arrival is 2025
 - Working with MNDOT on the project completing some last minute paperwork and will hopefully order bus early 2025
 - Facilities
 - Austin and Waseca facility approved through MNDOT grant Future projects
 - As noted earlier Received federal grant for these projects
 - Will work with MNDOT in coming weeks and months to determine timelines and requirements for project(s)
 - Other
 - Received funding through a 2024 Technology Grant for additional camera hardware that will assist managers with accessing video footage
 - Installation taking place this week (as we speak)
 - Submitted 2025 Technology Grant application for new routing software
 - Awaiting announcement of awards (like vehicle grant above)
 - Submitted Capital grant for staff support vehicle possible approval in the near future
- Big Picture Down the Road
 - Resume normal service hours

- As SMART continues to hire more staff, we will evaluate our services and resume previously suspended services as we are able
- Cedar Valley Services Update
 - Update on grant process looking to get additional funding from the state and/or federal government(s) to secure additional dollars for projects (100% or 80%, etc.)
 - Working through Cedar Valley Services training program updated with online training program
 - Part of the 245D licensing requirements CVS follows with the state
 - Continue to plug away with SMART and our services
